 I started working at Mayfield School in September 2012 for 5 years and following a short break returned in September 2018.

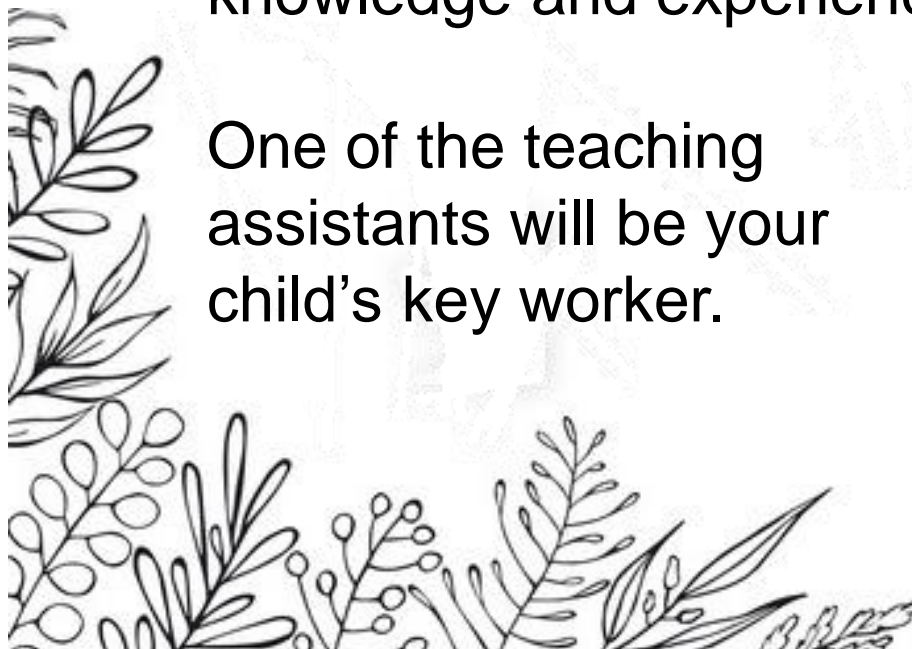
 I have extensive experience in KS3 and KS4, working with a range of pupil abilities and needs.

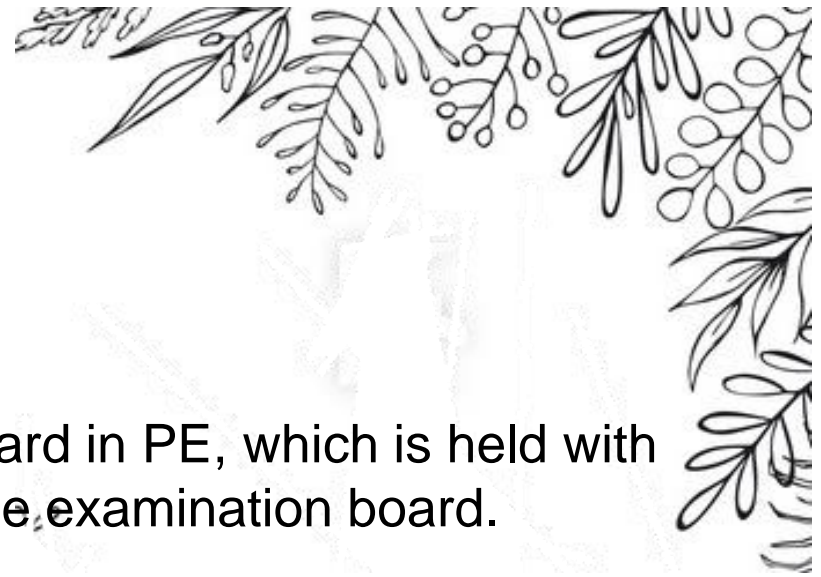
✿ Our class name is C2 and we will be located in C Cluster in Mayfield School, Wheeler street site.

-  In KS4 pupils complete accredited units in English, Maths and Science with OCR examination board.
-  Pupils will achieve an accredited award in PE, which is held with the Welsh Joint Education Committee examination board.
-  In KS4 the focus is to support pupils in building their independent living skills alongside their academic learning. To develop these skills pupils have the opportunity, over the two years in KS4, to achieve a Duke of Edinburgh bronze award.
-  Pupils also begin to explore future job prospects and career choices and where appropriate carry out work experience. This is explored further in KS5 and will help your child to develop the necessary skills for a successful future in Mayfield School and beyond.




# KS4 Breakfast Cafe

A very exciting part of KS4 is the 'KS4 Breakfast Café' where pupils run a café to pupils across the school.

- They will have the opportunity to trial positions within the café and then apply and interview for their chosen positions.
